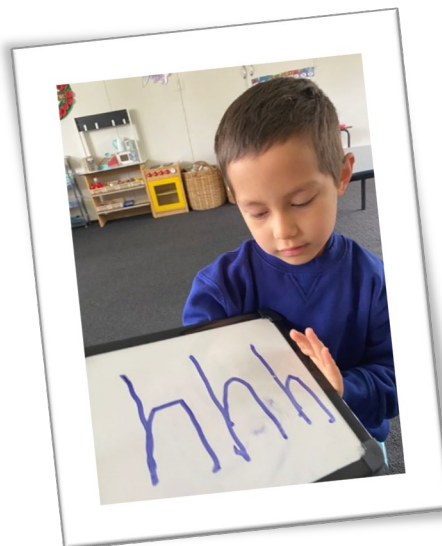
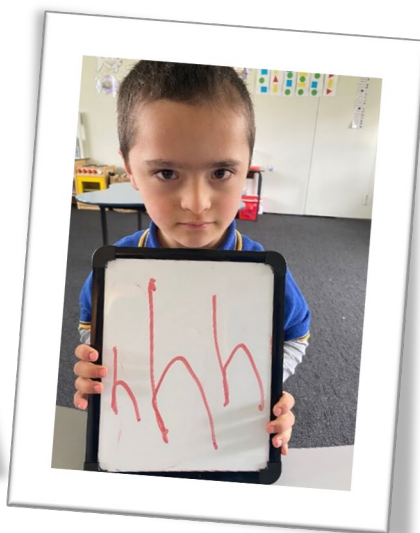

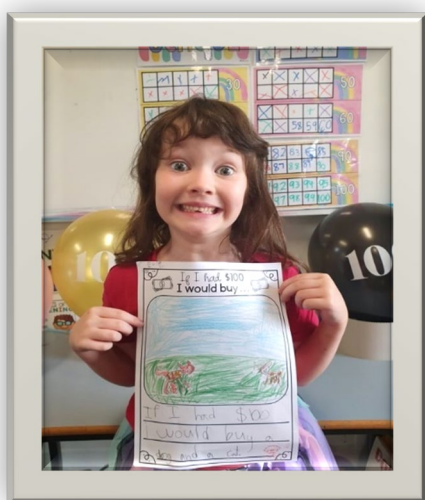
Support unit

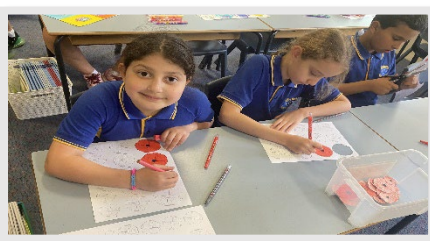
Stage 1 (Year 1 and 2)
