

In 1923 the school opened with just one building adjacent to the Hume Highway. As enrolments grew, more buildings were added to facilitate an Infants Department, a Boys Department and a Girls Department (that's right, in the primary, boys and girls were once in separate classes).



Preschool

Healthy Harold

Healthy Harold visited our Preschool to teach the children how to be super safe. The children listened to the story 'Super Safe Harold' and learned about how to be safe in the car, leaving preschool, in the home, near water, and how to ask for help.










Stage 1 Learning




